# PAEDIATRIC ALS-1 COURSE OVERVIEW

This Paediatric Advanced Life Support Level 1 course will provide you with the skills and knowledge to manage a paediatric patient in the immediate period of crisis. It includes the recognition, assessment and management of the deteriorating child.

Participants are provided with a comprehensive course workbook prior to the course to prepare for the face-to-face and practical components. This includes those skills for managing a paediatric patient in cardiac arrest and other medical emergencies in a clinical setting. The course is facilitated by accredited instructors from Emergency Medical Training Australasia.

## Course content:

- Recognition and initial management of the seriously ill child
- Airway management skills
- Basic Life Support and CPR
- Emergency circulatory access, fluid administration and medications
- Defibrillation skills (Manual and/or AED modes)
- Cardiac arrest management using the ARC ALS algorithm
- Practical workshops and simulations

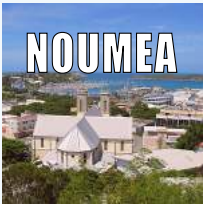

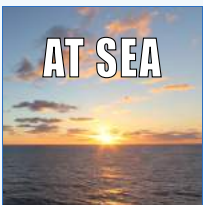
